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The federal Ministry of Energy has elaborated the draft Government Decree to define the conditions of control centralization in isolated power systems

SO UPS will accept functions of isolated power systems dispatching control from January 1st, 2024.

The Ministry of Energy of the Russian Federation has elaborated the draft Government Decree which defines the conditions related to operation and dispatching control in isolated power systems functions transfer to the SO UPS as well as operational aspects in isolated power systems during transition period.

Draft document goes in line with the amendments to the Federal Law on Electricity Industry adopted in June 2022. The amended Law improves the legislative framework for coordinating the long-term development planning of the United Power System of Russia and ensures centralized dispatching control in isolated power systems.

Currently the responsibilities of system operation and dispatching control in isolated power systems – the city of Norilsk, Chukotka Autonomous Region, Kamchatka Territory, Magadan and Sakhalin regions – are undertaken by the regional energy companies. The draft Decree establishes a legal basis for the functions transfer including the exchange of documents and information between SO UPS and regional utilities. At the same time, starting 2023 SO UPS will participate in dispatching control in isolated power systems and coordination of maintenance schedules.

The Ministry states that to enhance the system's reliability the centralized approach will be applied throughout the country, and it is of high priority to maintain the stable functioning of the electric power industry.

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
